With funding support from the Southeast Asia Node of the ARC Asia Pacific Futures Research Network, a number of travel bursaries of up to \$500 are now available for postgraduate students working on Southeast Asia to participate in the Ninth International Women in Asia Conference to be held at the University of Queensland 29 September-1 October.

The Women in Asia (WIA) Conferences have been held regularly since 1981 and are supported by the Women's Forum of the Asian Studies Association of Australia. The theme for the 2008 conference is *Transition and Interchange*, which we hope will stimulate discussion on temporal and geo-cultural changes and interactions that may be understood in many different ways and in many different contexts.

Applications for travel bursaries are invited from students currently enrolled in postgraduate research degrees on topics relating to women in Southeast Asia. Your application should include a 250-word abstract of the proposed presentation, a short CV, a statement of the benefits to your research and career goals expected from attendance at the conference, details of any funding support available from your home institution and a letter of support from your supervisor.
