#### NOTES FOR APPLICANTS:

- Applications are encouraged from projects that:
  - focus on Japan and/or Korea
  - cross disciplinary and institutional boundaries
  - demonstrate a commitment to broad communication of results
  - engage relevant community and industry partners
  - support and build leadership skills in ECRs and Postgraduates
- Workshops and conferences will be funded
- The node can provide funding for airfares and accommodation, including international and domestic travel for overseas and Australian scholars
- If you are applying for support for an existing program (e.g. biennial conferences) you must demonstrate how the proposal will add significantly new scope to this existing program in keeping with the scheme's mission to create dynamic, new research synergies
- Research projects, publication costs, honoraria, personnel, venue hire or conference dinners will **not** be funded
- All funded projects must acknowledge the Japan/Korea node of the ARC-APFRN in publicity & reporting materials
- All recipients will provide a report to the Japan/Korea node on completion of the project
- Project funding maximum \$3000 (grants above this amount will be considered in exceptional circumstances)
